There are various types of physical disabilities that impact user interaction on the web. Skip to Main Content:

Used to jump to the main content area.

Photographs/Images:

SURS uses Alternative Text ?ALT? and/or ?TITLE? attributes whenever possible. ALT/TITLE attributes provide a written description of the image, which is accessible to screen readers, and it is visible when the mouse is placed over the image. This is also useful for people who have images turned off on their browser, in which case a description will display where the image used to be.

Screen Readers:

SURS has implemented better html navigation for screen reader technology. In the future, SURS plans to provide additional features to improve upon this feature.

Breadcrumbs:

Located at the top of each page directly below the main navigation, a trail of where you are and where you have been. Breadcrumbs make it easier to navigate your way back to previous pages and sections of the website.
